

**CENTRAL COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
DEWITT - GRAND MOUND - LOW MOOR – WELTON**

The Central Community School Board of Education met for a board development session regarding a budget workshop on March 11, 2015, at the Central Middle School Media Center at 5:30 p.m. Directors Steve Fuglsang, Jim Irwin, Jennifer Naeve and Angela Rheingans were present along with Superintendent Peterson and Secretary Bartels. Administrators present were: George Pickup, Kurt Kreiter and Amy Wichman.

The Central Community School Board of Education met for a regular board meeting on March 11, 2015, at the Central Middle School Media Center at 6:00 p.m. Directors Steve Fuglsang, Jim Irwin, Jennifer Naeve, and Angela Rheingans were present along with Superintendent Peterson and Secretary Bartels. Administrators present were: George Pickup, Kurt Kreiter and Amy Wichman. Media representatives Kate Howes, The Observer, and Jan Huffman, Clinton Herald were also present.

Opening of Meeting

President Fuglsang opened the meeting at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Moved by Director Irwin, Director Naeve to approve the tentative agenda as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

Moved by Director Irwin, Director Rheingans to approve the minutes of February 11th. Motion carried 4-0.

Public comments – Mr. Greubel reported on the recent band events. He mentioned that there would be Drum Circle this weekend and that students are looking forward to the upcoming New York trip.

Information & Discussion Item(s)

Mr. Pickup introduced Mr. Prombo and Mr. Truelsen, HS Industrial Tech teachers. They gave a presentation on future plans for the Building Trades program.

Mr. Pickup gave a report on recent high school activities. He thanked The Observer for reporting on all the positive things happening within the school district.

Mr. Kreiter mentioned that the Boys Basketball team won, for the 2nd year in a row, the Iowa Hall of Pride Challenge; they were one of five teams in the state to win. He also mentioned that the third annual Strength & Conditioning Fundraiser is under way.

Mrs. Wichman mentioned that several grants have been written and submitted for the First Tech Challenge and various STEM opportunities. The English Language Arts K-6

teachers have been working on Iowa Core alignment. Hiring for TLC positions for the 2015-16 school year continues.

Director Kunz joined the meeting via Facetime.

Director Fuglsang reported that he has been in contact with representatives of both parties of the legislature in hopes to get them to compromise on a State Percent of Growth.

Action Item(s)

Superintendent Peterson reviewed the facilities and capital projects plan. No board action needed at this point.

Director Kunz's Facetime connection was lost and she left the meeting.

Moved by Director Irwin, Director Rheingans to approve the Mississippi Bend Area Education Agency (MBAEA) Induction Consortium in Partnership with New Teacher Center (NTC). Motion carried 4-0.

Moved by Director Irwin, Director Rheingans to approve the Personnel Report as follows:

Recommendation to hire Karin McCulloh for the position of Middle School Family Consumer Science Teacher starting with the 2015-2016 school year. She should be placed on BA step 4 of the 2015-2016 master contract.

Recommendation to increase the contract of Hailey Delf, High School Language Arts Teacher, from the current .75 to Full Time beginning with the 2015-2016 school year.

Recommendation to transfer Katie Burgmeier, Guidance Counselor, from her current location at the Elementary School to the Intermediate School starting with the 2015-2016 school year.

Resignation of Bethany Hovland from her position as Special Education Teacher at Ekstrand, effective at the end of the 2014-2015 school year.

Recommendation to hire Sydney Gray as a 1st Grade Teacher starting with the 2015-2016 school year. She should be placed on BA step 1 of the 2015-2016 master contract.

Recommendation to hire Megan Till as a 3rd Grade Teacher starting with the 2015-2016 school year. She should be placed on BA step 5 of the 2015-2016 master contract.

Recommendation to hire Kayla Naber as a 6th Grade Teacher starting with the 2015-2016 school year. She should be placed on BA step 1 of the 2015-2016 master contract.

Recommendation to hire Melissa Dever as a 6th Grade Teacher starting with the 2015-2016 school year. She should be placed on BA step 1 of the 2015-2016 master contract.

Recommendation to transfer Tatiana McConnell from her current position as 5th Grade Teacher to 4-6th Grade Reading Teacher (1.0 FTE) starting with the 2015-2016 school year.

Resignation of Michael McGruder from his positions as Physical Education Teacher at Ekstrand, and Assistant Varsity Girls Basketball Coach, effective at the end of the 2014-2015 school year.

Resignation of Michael Ernst from his position as Assistant Varsity Boys Basketball Coach, effective immediately.

Resignation of Coach Mark Kurtz from his position as Head Varsity Girls Basketball Coach, effective immediately.

Retirement of Rosie Biel from her position as Cook at Central Intermediate School. Her last day will be March 31, 2015.

Amendment to the Letter of Assignment of Mallory Shumate, Cook at Intermediate School, from 4 hours/day to 5.5 hours/day starting on April 1, 2015. Rate of pay stays the same at \$13.35/hour.

Retirement of Pat Lannen from his position as Bus Driver, effective at the end of the 2014-2015 school year.

Motion carried 4-0.

Superintendent Peterson reviewed the 2015-2016 School Year Calendar options. The board decided to table action until the legislature makes a decision.

Secretary Bartels presented the financial summary report for February 2015. Moved by Director Naeve, Director Rheingans to approve the secretary's financial report as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

Moved by Director Irwin, Director Naeve to set the date of the public hearing for amending the 2014-2015 Budget as April 8th at 6:00pm in the Central Middle School Media Center. Motion carried 4-0.

Moved by Director Irwin, Director Rheingans to set the date of the public hearing for the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year Certified Budget as April 8th at 6:00pm in the Central Middle School Media Center. Motion carried 4-0.

Moved by Director Rheingans, Director Irwin to approve the resolution to levy property taxes for fiscal year 2015-2016 for the regular program budget adjustment as allowed under section 257.14, Code of Iowa. Motion carried 4-0.

Roll call vote: Irwin-aye, Naeve-aye, Rheingans-aye, and Fuglsang-aye.
