



# CENTRAL DEWITT COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

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Welcome back to another great year at Central DeWitt Community School District!

Registration is open and will consist of logging in to your Parent Portal, updating your student/household information and paying fees. If you don't have a computer or Internet access you are welcome to come to the MS Media Center Monday, Aug. 13, 3-7 pm to use a school computer. You are also welcome to come to the Administration Office, 331 E. 8<sup>th</sup> St., DeWitt, between 8 am and 4 pm Monday through Thursday to register on a computer there. Unfortunately you are not able to register through your mobile phone at this time.

## REGISTRATION PROCESS

### 1. UPDATE STUDENT/HOUSEHOLD INFORMATION

Log in to your Infinite Campus Parent Portal at:

In your inbox, you will find a link for Online Registration (**not** New Student – Online Registration), please click on that link and proceed.

Once you are in the Online Registration module, most information will be pre-populated, please review each tab and make any corrections. There is a **red** asterisk at fields that are mandatory and need to be completed. There is an Online Registration Help Guide at the district website under the District Info tab and then under Parent Information and Forms. Once you have completed each tab, you will arrive at a Submit screen, please click the Submit button to finish the process.

### 2. PAY FEES

Go back to your Portal account and click on the Payments Tab. All fees (required and optional) will be listed. All required fees need to be paid after you complete the registration process. Please use the e-check payment option, if possible, as there is a charge to the school district for credit card payments.

**Your student(s) are now registered for the 2018-2019 school year.**

2017-2018 free/reduced eligibilities will be honored up until Oct. 5, 2018. If you qualified last year, your status will remain the same up until Oct. 5, 2018, but **you must complete a new form to qualify beyond that date.** You are now able to apply electronically through your Parent Portal account under the Tab called Applications/Forms. A paper application can be found at our district website under the District info tab and then under Parent Information and Forms, or you can pick an application up at the Central Administration Center, 331 E. 8<sup>th</sup> St., DeWitt. We will also be sending paper copies home with each student the first week of school.

All **incoming 7<sup>th</sup> grade students and a parent along with all new 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> students and a parent** must attend a mandatory computer meeting or the student will not be issued a laptop for the 2018-2019 school year. That meeting is set for Aug. 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:30 pm in the CDPAC (located in the high school). If you attended the 7<sup>th</sup> grade orientation meeting this spring you do not need to attend. #### Important Dates:

- Tues. Aug. 21<sup>st</sup> at 5:00 – 6:00 pm: Elementary Unpack Your Backpack – You and your child will have a chance to meet their teacher, locate their desk and locker, and bring all of their school supplies
- Tues. Aug. 21<sup>st</sup> at 5:30 – 6:30 pm: Intermediate Unpack Your Backpack
- Tues. Aug. 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:00 – 7:00 pm: Middle School Open House
- Tues. Aug. 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:30 pm: Mandatory Computer Laptop meeting in the CDPAC for new students and parents to the district and 7<sup>th</sup> grade parents and students, unless you attended the 7<sup>th</sup> grade orientation in the spring, then you do not need to attend.
