Dear Central DeWitt Families,

We understand the benefits of having our students involved in extracurricular activities and are thankful for the opportunity to continue offering all 7th-12th grade activities at this time. Although the seasons might look different than normal, we feel the safety measures we're taking will lead to a positive experience for all participants and our community. Should COVID-19 concerns arise, extracurricular offerings and schedules may change at that time.

DATES: Central DeWitt's plan is to continue offering all activities. Some activities may be offered at different times of the year but our goal is to not have to cancel. This includes all Athletics, Band, Choir, FFA, FBLA, FCCLA, Robotics, Model UN, IA Youth Symposium, Speech, Student Council, and Drama. If other schools are not in session or cannot play it may lead to reworking schedules or finding a new date to play. High school activities are scheduled to start as planned. Middle school practices are set to start on Monday August 31st for football, cheer, and volleyball. Middle school cross country starts August 24th.

PRACTICE: Students will still practice every day even when Central DeWitt will be using the hybrid model. Students will be responsible for getting to practice on days they are not scheduled to be at school so please plan ahead.

ELIGIBILITY: If students have elected to do online learning they can still participate in extracurricular activities.

ATTENDANCE: We do not plan to limit attendance at Central DeWitt events at this time. This is subject to change if COVID-19 concerns arise. If other schools choose to limit attendance at their venues, we will communicate that information as it is received. If this happens, tickets will be issued to players for entry at the event.

MASKS: All students and spectators will need to wear a mask at all inside and outside events at Central DeWitt. Masks will be required at the majority of MAC and other conference venues so please bring one with you.

SOCIAL DISTANCING: We ask you to please practice social distancing from other families at the events. We encourage you to bring lawn chairs and sit all around our football stadium. Spectators will not be allowed in the first row of bleachers for volleyball.

STREAMING: Thank you to Scott Drug Pharmacy and Gift Shop and First Central State Bank for your sponsorship toward this. This year we will be able to stream all high school and middle school activities that take place on our football field and in our competition gym. We are currently working with the NFHS Network but due to the most recent storm and backorders this will not be available until late September. We will communicate how to sign up for this option once the install is complete.

CONCESSIONS: Concession stands will be allowed to reopen August 24th. Coolers and outside food are not allowed at events. Instead, please support our boosters who sell concessions to raise money that helps our students.
